AVTA Adopts Local Business Outreach Policy

Lancaster, CA – Underscoring its belief that local businesses are important to the growth and development of the Antelope Valley, the Antelope Valley Transit Authority unanimously adopted its Local Business Outreach Policy at a recent Board meeting.

“The policy is intended to ensure local businesses have opportunities to compete for, and receive a fair share of, AVTA’s procurement opportunities,” noted AVTA Board Chair Norm Hickling. While it is believed the policy will not result in any significant impact to AVTA overall expenditures, it supports an environment wherein highly skilled suppliers/vendors may compete successfully while also encouraging large businesses to increase subcontracting opportunities for local firms.
