Chief Financial Officer Judy Vaccaro-Fry presented information regarding legislation focused on transportation worker safety, the Public Employee's Pension Reform Act and 13(c) litigation, the proposed Federal Budget for FY 2024, FTA Property Disposition, changes to the National Transit Database, the Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) Discretionary Grant Program, SB-2 Energy: Transportation fuels: Supply and Pricing: Maximum Gross Gasoline Refining Margin, California Road Charge (mileage-based user fee), several State Senate and Assembly bills, and MTA's proposed annual formula allocation for AVTA.
